Dear Mr. Schoch:

Enclosed is Part II of the Penn Manor School District's Management Plan as required by the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) of 1986. Part II includes the Operations and Maintenance (O & M) Plan for training of Maintenance and Custodial Personnel, Work Practices, and Periodic Surveillance to maintain friable Asbestos-Containing Materials (ACBM) in good condition, ensure clean-up of asbestos fibers previously released, and prevent further release by minimizing and controlling friable ACBM disturbance or damage. Part I, which has been sent under previous cover and also included in this document, includes the Asbestos Assessment and Inventory Study. The inspection of the Penn Manor School District Buildings for all locations of friable and non-friable ACBM was performed in December, 1987 and January, 1988. This report details the physical inspection, bulk sampling and analysis, and assessment of the conditions of the friable and non-friable ACBM within the School Buildings.

The Penn Manor School District Management Plan should be used as a planning tool in handling the Asbestos Programs.

- 1. The submittal of this plan to the Governor of Pennsylvania shall be no later than October 12, 1988.
- If any buildings are leased or acquired by the School District for use as School Buildings after October 12, 1988, the buildings must be included in the Plan.
- Any revision of the Plan also must be submitted to the Governor of Pennsylvania.
- 4. Penn Manor School District must begin implementation of their Management Plan by July 9, 1989, and must complete implementation in a timely manner.

5. The Management Plan must be updated to keep it current with on-going surveillance, inspection, reinspection and response action activities. VES remains available to provide the Penn Manor School District with continuous surveillance, inspection, reinspection and response action activities.
